



# GEL 2530 - Introduction to Geologic Field Work

## FIELD NOTEBOOK GRADING

Your Field-Notebook will determine the grade in this course and several entries will be evaluated by your professor. You may choose which of your notebook entries are to be graded, however NO DOUBLE DIPPING is allowed. For example, your “Mapping Project” you want to be graded can not also be chosen as your “Geopuzzle”. Each assessment must stand on its own merits.

When you are ready to turn in your Field Notebook for grading, create sticky note tabs or similar and mark the pages and exercises you want to be graded. Please have one of each from the following list:

GRADED EXERCISE	Description	Notebook Label
Field Methods Exam	Mark the page where your EXAM was recorded.	FM Exam
Sampling Method	Select a notebook entry describing where and how a sample was taken	Sample
Geopuzzle	Select your notebook entry showing your selected Geopuzzle and solution	GeoPuzzle
Field Exercises	Select any additional field exercise such as measurements, detailed description, sketch, estimation	Field X#1
	Select an additional field exercise, a weight of geologic material estimation	Field X#2 W
	Select an additional field exercise, a height estimation of your choice	Field X#3 HI
	Select a field notebook MAPPING exercise such as the base camp or any other map produced and recorded in your notebook	Field X#4 MAP
	Select a field notebook STRATIGRAPHIC SECTION exercise that shows a stratigraphic column produced with your detailed description of the units	Field X#5 STRAT

There should be EIGHT (8) labels attached to your notebook.

**Turn in your notebook with the marked labels by END OF JUNE!!!**
